GATEWAYS OF OPPORTUNITY

Gil Cloyd started college in 1963 at Ohio State's Lima campus, later transferring to Columbus and earning a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree. Now Procter & Gamble's chief technology officer, Dr. Cloyd is the new chair of Ohio State's Board of Trustees.

The regional campuses—Lima, Mansfield, Marion, Newark—and the Agricultural Technical Institute in Wooster account for nearly 30% of Ohio State's incoming freshmen and 16% of all undergraduates. For the past two years, about 13% of our bachelor's degree recipients started at a regional campus.

With competitive admissions and high demand putting spaces on the Columbus campus at a premium, regional campuses provide access for many who otherwise could not aspire to an Ohio State diploma.

Let Dr. Cloyd be a lesson.
