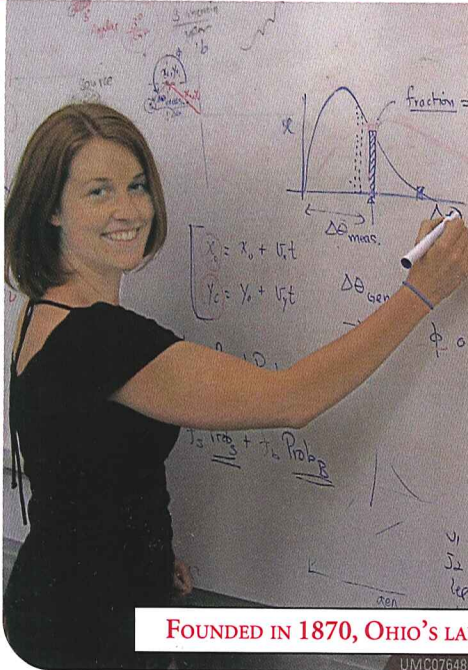


# Buckeye Brief #15
